Volunteers Needed: The Northern Middlesex County Regional Domestic Violence Response Team, who serves the communities of Edison and Metuchen, along with the students and faculty attending Middlesex County College. Applicants must be 18 years of age or older with a valid driver's license, possess good communication skills in the English language (A second language is helpful) and submit to a mandatory background check.
