## What is Register Ready?

*Register Ready is a free, secure, voluntary database designed to help emergency managers and first responders plan for and support people with disabilities and access and functional needs (DAFN).*

*You (or someone on your behalf) are encouraged to register if you have a physical, developmental, cognitive, or behavioral impairment.*



## Who Should Register?

*Permanent and seasonal NJ residents with DAFN who may need help evacuating, sheltering in place or at a public shelter, or requiring emergency assistance should register. Individuals with a temporary disability, such as a high-risk pregnancy or other serious medical condition, should register.*
