# Liaison Reports:

- Metuchen School District: Principal Porowski while absent, shared that MHS staff will engage in a presentation on Supporting Transgender and Gender Expansive Students on 2/7/22 with Samantha King from Children's Hospital of Philadelphia.
- MDA: Bobbie reported on several events in the planning stages
  - There is a Lunar New Year celebration being planned for the Plaza and Downtown. The tentative date is 2/12. The HRC is asked to support the event and promote it.
  - O Black History Month, the MDA has developed a large BHM poster for display at the Plaza. They are also hoping to create an event and would like to partner with the HRC.
  - Holi: The MDA is planning an event to educate others around the cultural significance behind Holi.
  - Juneteenth & Hispanic Heritage Day: There are plans to continue these celebrations this year.
  - Holocaust Rememberance Day is on Jan. 27th and the HRC may want to plan a social media post about it.
  - Many Afghani refugees are moving into the area. This may be something that the HRC can partner with Interfaith RISE to bring awareness to and educate the community on how to help families feel included and offer help. Perhaps a Community conversation on how to be a better ally?
  - Thomas Mundy Peterson Day of Democracy in early October: A day to promote the power
    of the vote and educate others on the achievements of Thomas Mundy Peterson. Possible
    planning should begin around May/June.
- **Metuchen High School**: Michelle joined the Student Equity Committee at MHS. She shared that the committee is working on ways to revise the ELA & Social Studies textbooks to ensure that various perspectives are considered.
- Metuchen Council: Joel reported that Jason Delia is the new Council President
- **Board of Education** Hazel-Anne reported that the District will have virtual learning for 1/3 1/5. In-person learning will resume on 1/6.
