# ORDINANCE AMENDING § 162-4 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF METUCHEN AMENDING THE COMPOSITION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE DESIGNATED DISTRICT MANAGEMENT CORPORATION - THE METUCHEN DOWNTOWN ALLIANCE

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Metuchen has created and designated a Special Business Improvement Zone; and

**WHEREAS** the Borough of Metuchen designated the "Metuchen Downtown Alliance," a NJ Non-Profit Corporation as the District Management Corporation relating to the Special Business Improvement District and set forth the composition of the Board of Trustees of District Management Corporation in § 162-4 of the Code of the Brough of Metuchen; and

WHEREAS, the Metuchen Downtown Alliance Board of Trustees have met and voted to amend the membership of its Board of Trustees and has requested the Mayor and Council of the Borough to amend § 162-4 of the Code of the Borough of Metuchen to reflect the change in the composition of the membership of the Board of Trustees replacing the member of the Metuchen Area Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors and Board member of the Metuchen Parking Authority with an additional representative of the District Businesses and an additional Metuchen resident who does not own commercial real estate and/or operate a business in the District and who is not on the Borough Council nor employed by the Borough; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the Borough of Metuchen have determined, based upon the request of the Board of Trustees of the Metuchen Downtown Alliance to amend § 162-4 of the Code of the Borough of Metuchen to reflect the change in the composition of the membership of the Board of Trustees of the District Management Corporation – the Metuchen Downtown Alliance accordingly.

**NOW THEREFRORE BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Borough of Metuchen, County of Middlesex that it hereby amends § 162-4 of the Code of the Borough of Metuchen to state as follows:

### § 162-4 Composition of District Management Corporation.

A. General powers. The business and affairs of the District Management Corporation shall be managed by a Board of Trustees which may exercise all powers of the Corporation and perform all lawful acts for a corporation pursuant to the laws of the state of New Jersey governing "not for profit" corporations.

- B. Number, selection and tenure of trustees. The Corporation shall be governed by a Board of Trustees consisting of 13 voting members and one ex-officio non-voting member. The 13 voting members shall consist of:
- (1) Four representatives of District owners. "District owner" shall be defined as an owner of real estate within the District. A "District owner" may or may not operate a business within the District in order to be considered a "District owner":
- (2) Four Five representatives of District Businesses. "District business" shall be defined as a person, corporation or other business entity operating a business within the District. A "District business" may or may not own real estate within the District in order to be considered a "District business";
- (3) One member of the Borough Council of Metuchen appointed by the Mayor with the advice and consent of the Borough Council,
- (4) One member of the Metuchen Area Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors to be appointed by and serves at the pleasure of the Metuchen Area Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors;
- (45) One Two Metuchen residents who does not own commercial real estate and/or operate a business in the District and who is are not on the Borough Council nor employed by the Borough;
- (<u>56</u>) One member of the Metuchen Arts Council to be appointed by and serves at the pleasure of the Metuchen Arts Council.; and
- (7) One board member of the Metuchen Parking Authority to be appointed by and serves at the pleasure of the Metuchen Parking Authority.

In addition, to the 13 voting members, there shall be two ex-officio members of the Board with all powers and authority of a regular Board member, however, shall not be entitled to vote on matters: (1) the Administrator of the Borough of Metuchen or his/her designee, and (2) one member of the Metuchen Parking Authority to be appointed by and serves at the pleasure of the Metuchen Parking Authorityshall be an exofficio member of the Board with all powers and authority of a regular Board member, however, shall not be entitled to vote on matters.

In the event that any category(ies) of a voting Board member cannot be filled for any reason whatsoever, the District Management Corporation shall set forth in its bylaws, the terms and methods to fill all seats on the Board of Trustees.

C. Terms and appointment of Board of Trustees. The District Management Corporation shall provide for, in its bylaws, the terms and appointment or election of the four District owners, <u>fourfive</u> District businesses and the <u>two</u> Metuchen resident voting members of the Board of Trustees.

The initial appointments and terms thereof to the Board of Trustees shall be as set forth in the Borough Code. It shall not <u>be</u> necessary for the initial composition of the Board of Trustees to be in full compliance with Section 162-4B above. However, after the initial appointments and expiration of terms, the composition of the Board shall be comprised as set forth in Section 162-4B above.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that the seats of the members of the Board of Trustees created herein shall be filled pursuant to the bylaws of the District Management Corporation – Metuchen Downtown Alliance as if a vacancy was created in each of the membership classification.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phase of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the remaining portion of this ordinance shall not be affected thereby and shall remain in full force and effect, and to that end the provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable; and

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this amending ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of their inconsistencies only; and

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that this ordinance shall be in full force and take effect after final passage and publication, as required by law.

## AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF METUCHEN, VARIOUS CHAPTERS, CERTAIN APPLICATION, REGISTRATION, LICENSE AND PERMIT FEES

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Borough Council of the Borough of Metuchen, as follows:

#### Section 1.

Section **87-23** of Chapter 87, **Fees, Article 14** – **Senior Citizen Program Fees**, of the Code of the Borough of Metuchen, is hereby amended to add/change/delete the registration and permit fees to read as follows:

### § 87-23 Fees established.

- A. There shall be an annual registration fee for the period January 1 to December 31, for non-resident senior citizens (age sixty (60) and over) in the amount of \$\frac{30.0060.00}{30.0060.00}\$ per person. The payment of the annual registration fee shall be required prior to the participation and/or use by any non-resident senior citizen of the Metuchen Senior Center or participation in any program, event and/or service offered at the Metuchen Senior Center. The payment of such registration fee shall be in addition to any costs or fee established by the Borough for the participation in an event, service or program.
- B. The payment of the annual registration fee shall not provide a non-resident senior any right or entitlement to any or all of the benefits, programs, assistance and services offered by the Borough of Metuchen to the Borough of Metuchen Senior Citizens. The payment of the above annual registration fee set forth above shall be solely for the eligibility to participate in events, programs and services offered at the Metuchen Senior Citizen Center and shall not be a guarantee, license or entitlement to any services offered by the Borough of Metuchen.
- C. Senior Citizen Program Fees. In addition to those fees established above, fees are established for participation in the following programs:

\$5.00 to \frac{10.00}{\$20.00} (dependent upon the costs of luncheon)

\$20.00 to \$40.00\subseteq 150.00 (dependent upon cost of bus rental)

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, by the Council of the Borough of Metuchen that it hereby authorizes and directs the Metuchen Seniors Commission in coordination with the Borough Administrator and the Director of the Metuchen Senior CenterRecreation/ Senior Services to establish practices and procedures relating to the collection, enforcement and monitoring of the annual registration fee for non-resident seniors, including but not limited to providing notice to the seniors, the creation of an application for non-resident seniors, and the pro-ration of the annual registration fee, when applicable which will be equal to 50% of the full-year membership for members joining after June 30, and the fees to be charged for the programs, services and events in accordance with the aforementioned guidelines; and

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that if any part of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance; and

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or amended to the extent of such inconsistency; and

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** by the Council of the Borough of Metuchen that this ordinance shall take effect after passage and publication as required by law, except that the annual registration fee for non-resident seniors shall become effective January 1, 20172023.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ENTRY INTO AND THE EXECUTION OF A SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE BOROUGH OF METUCHEN AND THE BOROUGH OF METUCHEN BOARD OF EDUCATION FOR THE USE OF EDGAR FIELD AND THE EDGAR FIELD IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Metuchen ("Borough") is the owner and responsible for the maintenance of Edgar Field located in the Borough of Metuchen; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has permitted the Metuchen Board of Education ("Board" or "School District") access and use of Edgar Field for educational and school purposes; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough sought assistance from the State of New Jersey for improvements to Edgar Field, and the State Budget Bill appropriated \$2,000,000 to the Board of Education for Astroturf for the field; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough and the School District both use the Edgar Field for athletic, recreation, Borough and School District purposes; and

WHEREAS, municipalities and school districts often enter into shared services agreements that enable the residents of their communities to utilize their facilities owned by either as community facilities for school and municipal services, including athletic, recreational, school building and other facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Borough and the School District have determined that it is the most cost effective and in the best interests of the Borough, the School District and the residents thereof for the Borough and the School District to jointly provide for the Edgar Field Improvement Project, involving the installation of an Astroturf field, drainage improvements and equipment, including incidental and related costs, including the planning and financing of the improvements (the "Project"); and

**WHEREAS,** the Project is estimated to exceed \$2,000,000 of State Funds available to the School District and the Borough has agreed to fund the remaining costs of the improvements to the Project; and

**WHEREAS,** as the owner of the property, the Borough will oversee and provide for the implementation of the Project and for the cost of maintenance and upkeep of Edgar Field; and

**WHEREAS**, the Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act, *N.J.S.A.* 40A:65-1 et seq., authorizes and encourages local units, including municipalities and

school districts, to enter into contracts for services performed by local units in accordance with law for the purpose of reducing property taxes through reduction of expenses; and

**WHEREAS,** municipalities and school districts are expressly authorized to work together for the provision of improvements that can be used for athletic, recreational, educational and other community purposes; and
