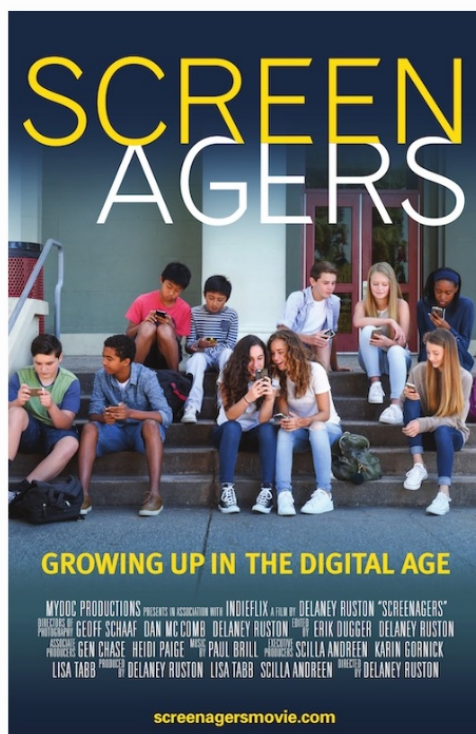


Documentary Film Screening & Discussion
